Events held in the latter part of 2019: The annual Kastellorizian of the Year was awarded to **Freda Miriklis** at a sparkling event at the KAV on 12 October. The event was a sell-out and attracted a great deal of publicity.

On 16th and 17th November Philippa Adgemis and Michele Kiosoglous launched their second book, **Kleio and Despina**, dedicated to the courage of the **Lady of Ro**. The two launces were held at the KAV. The cocktail party on the 16th and the children's event on the 17th both attracted large numbers.

On November 24th, for the third year running the **KAV Family Christmas Party** was held at Phoenix Park. Weather-wise it was a perfect day for a party, and the kids loved it.


Events sponsored by the KAV: two seminars at the Greek Orthodox Community of Melbourne. In May 2019 the first sponsored seminar was by Dr Andonis Piperoglou on the subject – **Making Greek Australia: Rethinking History, Ethnicity and Belonging.** The second sponsored seminar on 27 June 2019 was by Phil Kafcaloudes on the subject – **Homer and the Story of a Greek Australian War** Hero. The third was cancelled due to C-19

Despite 2020's challenges, the KAV committee continued meeting monthly via Zoom.

Heritage Project An oral history project to document the lives/stories of Victorian Kazzies was

initiated, thanks to the Heritage Project subcommittee.

The KAV Building In the past year the front of the building has been leased to BodyFit who have completed renovations to professionally fit it out as a gym. The entrance is restored and complements the surroundings. The rear of the building has also undergone renovations. The courtyard area has been floored and larger and more secure display cabinets installed. Fire-exit compliant glass doors were also installed at the entrance.



Kazzie Connect was established in September 2020, to help keep our members connected. Three sessions featured European Correspondent Emma Gavalas, Captain George Kailis and consulgeneral of Greece, Mr Dimitrios Michalopoulos speaking about the Turkish-Greek situation, and newly-elected Lord Mayor of Perth Basil Zempilas. **The KazziE-Bulletin** continued during Covid-19 lockdown keeping members informed on what was happening with our building, news of what was happening on Kastellorizo and general news of interest to our members and friends.

Newsletter Indexation Our dedicated Archivist Florence Livery has indexed all newsletters and ebulletins up until the end of 2020. The Index is on our website and is a valuable resource for all of us, and future generations. Throughout the year Florence was also kept busy answering archival queries.

Future Events Last year marked the KAV's 95th anniversary, but of course celebrations needed to be put on hold. With this year being also the 200th Anniversary of Greek Independence consideration is being given to a combined event to mark the 200th Anniversary and the 96th Anniversary of the KAV. In the meantime, the committee is currently working on events for 2021, including the Saints Constantine and Helen celebrations – COVID-19 permitting. In due course the committee will need to plan for the celebration of our centenary which is now only four years away.

- Each year the award identifies a person who has achieved excellence in their chosen field and brought honour to the Kastellorizan community.
- The presentation will be made at the Annual KOY Dinner on 16th October 2021. The recipient must be in attendance at this event to receive the award.
- \circ The successful candidate will be notified by 14 $^{th}\,$ August 2021.

Thank you for your decision to make a nomination for the 2021Kastellorizian of the Year Award.

Please be aware that some key changes have been to the application process including:

- \circ $\;$ You should make the Nominee aware of your intention to nominate them.
- This nomination will be valid for three years after the application is submitted. You should also make the Nominee aware of this. In 2021 nominations from 2018 and 2019 will be considered.
- All nominations need to be made on this nomination form and should be typed and submitted electronically.
- All sections are mandatory and must be completed in the format specified for the nomination to be eligible for consideration.
- Consent is expressly required from the Referee.
- Contact the Officer-in-Charge (see details Page 5) should you require assistance in completing this application.

Nomination Guidelines and Requirements

The Nominee:

- 1. Must be of Kastellorizian descent.
- 2. Must have demonstrated excellence in a field of endeavour and/or made an outstanding contribution to the Kastellorizian, Greek and / or Australian community.
- 3. Must be an inspirational role model for Kastellorizians.
- 4. Must agree to the nomination *and* it being valid for three consecutive years.
- 5. Cannot be a member of the KOY Selection Panel.
- 6. Cannot be self-nominated.

Nominations:

- 1. May be submitted by any member of any Kastellorizian association or community in Australia.
- 2. Nominations are valid for three consecutive years.
- 3. A person may be re-nominated after the three-year time limit has elapsed. A new nomination form however must be submitted.
- 4. Closing date for nominations is 5pm 1 July 2021.

- 5. Nomination form requirements:
 - All four sections (A D) must be completed for the nomination to be eligible for consideration.
 - The consent of the Nominee (Section A).
 - All three Selection Criteria (Section B) must be specifically addressed under each heading.
 - Extra supporting material (with a limit of 4 x A4 size pages) will be only considered if it is annotated, clearly explaining its relevance to the specific Selection Criteria (Section B).
 - A resume and / or biography (Section C).
 - A referee, with their express consent (Section D).
